Ryuu follows six dragons as they evolve from *bablings* to *big wings* as they become more socially adept in four stages of evolution. The dragons face challenges from 17 *Dark Forces* – invisible villains that steal social abilities – and receive assistance from 17 *Light Forces*, who help provide social successes.

Ontario ARC's Ryuu Game Night is geared towards children ages 8 - 14 who have autism or a related diagnosis. Young adults ages 15-21 will also learn the game and mentor new, young players through various stages of Ryuu.
